

We pray for the safety and well-being of those celebrating and for the grace to celebrate a holy, renewing Lenten season.








We pray for Brad Keith Sigmon, scheduled for execution in South Carolina, for the victims, and for their families.

Jewish Feast of Purim (13–14, sundown to sundown), celebrating the deliverance of the Jewish people from destruction.




14 Hindu Feast of Holi, celebrating the spring festival of colors

17 Feast of St. Patrick We pray in gratitude for the contributions to U.S. society by Irish Americans.


We pray for Christopher Sepolvado, scheduled for execution in Louisiana, for the victims, and for their families.

Bring to prayer the people you care about and send them your love and happiness.





We pray for the People of Central America / Abya Yala and for those denied their human rights.






