


First Freedom ride from Washington, D.C. to the South in 1961

We pray for peacemakers and the beatification of Catherine McAuley.




10 Feast of St. Damien of Molaki We pray for those with incurable conditions and for their caregivers.

Bro. Roger Schultz, founder of the Taizé community, born in 1915


13 Feasts of Our Lady of Fatima and Bl. Julian Norwich

We pray for peace in Ukraine, Palestine, Myanmar, Yemen, Iran, Iraq, Haiti, Sudan, Somalia











This is the 25th anniversary of the UN adopting the Declaration and Programme of Action on a Culture of Peace.











International Day of Light (UN)

19 Endangered Species Day (UN) We pray that governments would work together to preserve the diversity of our environment and help preserve the future of endangered species.




22 Feast of St. Rita of Cascia (patron of desperate causes)


